Key responsibilities

- Within the team, exhibit and promote the values that are in line with Commonwealth Games England and Swim England.
- Uphold all governance requirements across the team throughout, including but not limited to anti-doping requirements.
- Be responsible for ensuring effective safeguarding and welfare of both the athletes and workforce
- Provide support, guidance and communication to games team staff in a timely and appropriate manner.
- Attend Leadership Meetings online and face to face when required before and during the games
- Facilitate and participate in the appropriate 'debrief' session when required
- Produce a Team Managers' report on the Games to contribute to the holistic post games review
